Quebec Trail Permit:

The procedure for obtaining a trail permit has changed for 2020. We no longer have booklets of passes to fill out for you. **ALL permits are only sold online.**

The trail permit can only be purchased by the registered owner of the snowmobile; an account must be created in his/her name. Accepted online payment methods: VISA or MasterCard

The transaction is carried out on a secure site and no information related to your credit card will be retained once the transaction is complete.

Important information:

Alcohol – You agree not to consume ANY alcohol before riding a sled on our trips. If you violate our zero-tolerance policy at any time, you will have, without further notice from BVSA, automatically removed yourself from the tour. If you cannot abstain from having a beer with lunch, please do not join our tour. _____ Customer initial

Sled condition – Your snowmobile must be properly prepared for the trip. BVSA will provide a checklist of items to be serviced prior to the trip. Bringing an unprepared sled is not fair to others.

Legal – You agree to pay all costs to collect monies due BVSA including reasonable attorney’s fees and court costs.

We may cancel or modify a trip due to conditions and issue a refund to clients. If the trip is extended due to events, you agree to pay the daily rate for additional day/days.

You certify that you are aware of the riding demands of the trip. _____ Customer initial

A criminal conviction including DWI within last 5 years may result in denied entry in to Canada.

To ensure the safety of the group, the trip guide reserves the right to expel from the trip any person or persons engaging in behavior the guide deems to be disruptive or unsafe. There are no refunds in this event and the expelled party is responsible for the costs of returning to point of origin.

Terms and Conditions:

Important: You are participating in an adventure trip with risks and uncertainties, including but not limited to; poor weather conditions, snow and trail conditions, mechanical malfunction of the equipment and unforeseen events both natural and man-made. If it is your desire to remain in control at all times, you are most likely not suited for this type of trip.

A non-refundable deposit of \$250.00 USD per person is required to reserve trip.

The full payment is due 30 days prior to departure. The “contact” for a private trip must collect payment from each member of the group and forward the payments as a whole to BVSA.

The exchange rate of the U.S. - Canadian dollar is a factor in determining the cost of trip and as such the final cost is subject to adjustment.

I acknowledge that snowmobiling entails known and unanticipated risks that could result in physical or emotional injury, paralysis, death, or damage to me, to property, or to third parties. I understand that such risks simply cannot be eliminated without jeopardizing the essential qualities of the activity. _____ Initial here

The risks include, among other things: riding on uneven snow covered terrain, changing snow conditions and variations in elevations; loss of control of the snowmobile, falls from the snowmobile, collision with other snowmobiles, participants, trees, rocks, and other manmade or natural obstacles; exposure to the elements, extreme temperatures, inclement weather and encounters with animals and wildlife; burns; and mechanical and/or equipment problems and unavailability of immediate medical attention in case of injury. _____ Initial here

Furthermore, Bonvoyage Snow Adventures LLC (BVSA) employees have difficult jobs to perform. They seek safety, but they are not infallible. They might be unaware of a participant's fitness or abilities. They might misjudge the weather or other environmental conditions. They may give incomplete warnings or instructions, and the equipment being used might malfunction.

I expressly agree and promise to accept and assume all of the risks existing in this activity. My participation in this activity is purely voluntary, and I elect to participate in spite of the risks. _____ Initial here
