ARRIVE: La Malbaie

Arrive at the Trois Canard located just outside Quebec City between 3-5 pm. After check-in you have some time to yourself to address any last minute concerns. We recommend removing your sled from trailer and storing in locked corral overnight. Meet and greet in lounge at 6pm followed by dinner as a group. Review of safety and security procedures. Lodging: Trois Canard

DAY 1: La Malbaie /La Baie

Breakfast at the inn. If necessary, pick up any sled rentals next to hotel. First order is to get outside of town, after which we are riding through the mountains in Charlevoix. This is a fifty mile section of trail 83 that is very wide with sweeping turns. A great place to exercise your right thumb if you wish. Four course dinner at Auberge 21 in La Baie. Lodging: Auberge 21 Distance: 150 miles



DAY 2: La Baie/Auberge des îles

Breakfast at the inn. We pass through the city of Chicoutimi on the way to Monts Valin. This area normally has 30 weeks of snow. We are now going to discover the fabulous snow covered countryside of Quebec. Really nice photo opportunities this afternoon. Lodging and a spectacular dinner at the Auberge des îles **Lodging:** Auberge des îles **Distance:** 170 miles



DAY 3: Auberge des îles/Ravage

Breakfast. This day is spent in the nature of Charlevoix. Scenery can't get any better than this. Dinner and night is at an "off grid" log cabin with a warm fireplace and spectacular chef-prepared meal. **Lodging:** Auberge du Ravage **Distance:** 165 miles




DAY 4: Ravage/La Malbaie

DAY 5: Depart


Breakfast. Begin trip home.
